ROLE OF THE MENTOR

As the mentor of a Dental Nurse undergoing a the NEBDN National Diploma Course you will be expected to be a GDC registrant and support the student as follows:

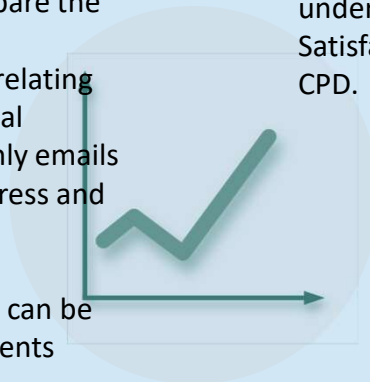
- Attend the face to face induction at Kings College Hospital
- Monitor the progress of the student throughout the course and support them where necessary
- Motivate them when they are struggling
- Liaise regularly with the course team
- Ensure access to all the procedures they require in order to complete the Record of Experience (ROE)
- Ensure all witnesses are aware of their responsibilities and support them in carrying them out
- Prepare for, administer and make assessment decisions for the workplace based Objective Structured Clinical Examinations (OSCEs).



MONITORING PROGRESS

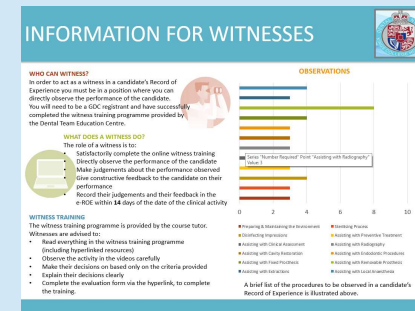
Throughout the course students are expected to complete teaching modules via the virtual learning environment (<https://dnetc-moodle.kch.nhs.uk>). At the end of each module there is an assignment to complete and either an online quiz or a workplace based OSCE. These are all designed to prepare the student for their final examination and are an essential component of the course. Mentors can access records relating to student progress via the 'Grades' section of the virtual learning environment. Mentors will also be sent monthly emails by the course team to ensure they are monitoring progress and adequately supporting their student in achieving their qualification.

The student's progress throughout the ROE completion can be monitored via the Candidate and Tutor Tracking documents available within their ROE.



WITNESS SUPPORT

The Dental Team Education Centre has produced an information sheet for witnesses which will be handed out during the course induction. Mentors should ensure **all** witnesses receive a copy of the information sheet and complete the necessary training required to become a witness.



WORKPLACE OSCEs

The Dental Team Education Centre have developed an online training package to support mentors in the administration, delivery and assessment of workplace OSCEs. Mentors are advised to complete this training package prior to undertaking workplace OSCEs with their student. Satisfactory completion of the training will count as 1 hours CPD.
